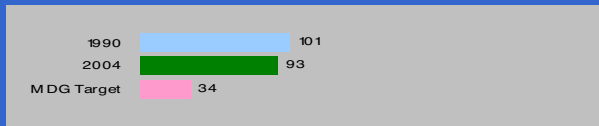

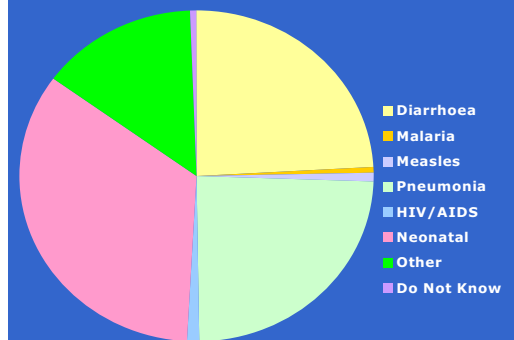
## Demographics

- Under-five mortality rate



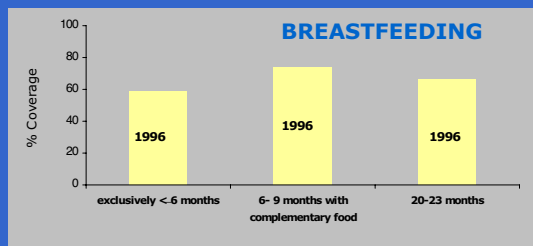
## Epidemiological Profile



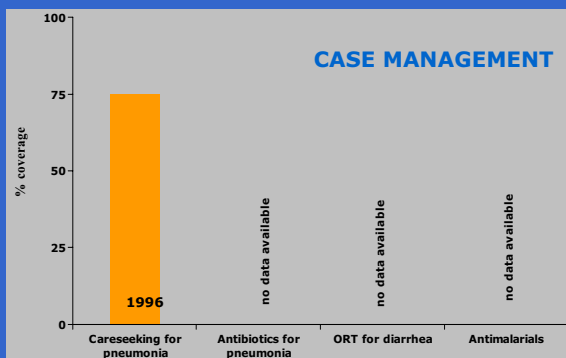
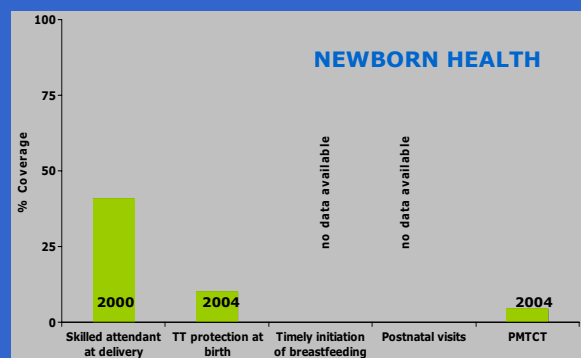
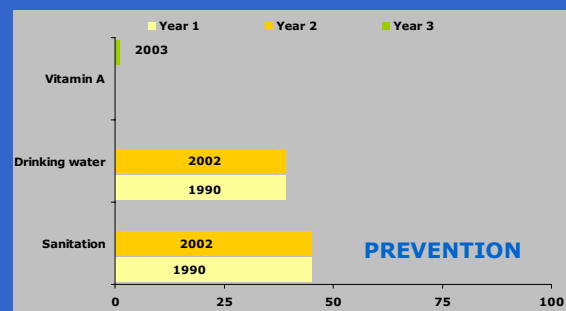
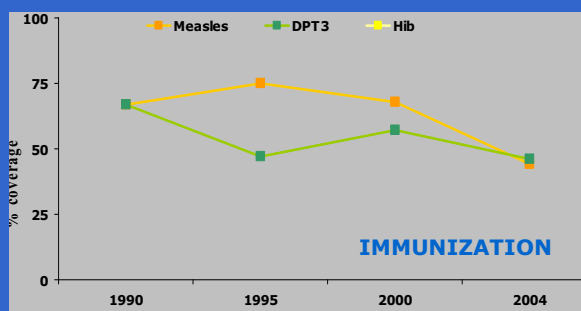
