Actions to accelerate MNCH/Survival in Pakistan

Actions to accelerate MNCH/Survival in Pakistan

- Stakeholders:
 - Parliamentarians – Advocacy for Resources, Legislation, Governance
 - Federal Government – Clarify and coordinate impacts of each Line Ministry on MNCH/Survival; policy formulation, implementation and evaluation across sectors as they affect MNCH;
 - Provincial Govts – Resource Allocation to Districts for MNCH; Monitoring
 - District Govts – Enhanced Service Delivery for MNCH; Functional Integration especially inking health and population services

Actions to accelerate MNCH/Survival in Pakistan

- Stakeholders (continued):
 - Development partners [UN, IFIs, Bilaterals]: Coherent support for Nat'l policies; stronger Joint Programmes; resources for new innovations for scaling up
 - NGOs, CSOs, Media, Professional Organisations: Support for piloting innovations; service delivery in marginalised areas; creating demand for services; watchdog for quality/equity at community level; bringing in evidence base for decision making

Actions to accelerate MNCH/Survival in Pakistan

- Stakeholder (cont'd):
 - Private Sector : provision of quality services to National standards; reporting on coverage to national monitoring system;
 - Religious Bodies: Raising awareness and acceptance of MNCH/Survival issues; supporting national policies for MNCH/survival; creating demand for quality services;

Afghanistan

- Strong commitment on part of the government
- Role of education for women

Bangladesh

- Get all the stakeholders together in a meeting and share their experiences
- Engage the media to disseminate the information

Cambodia

- Organize a formal briefing with the minister of health, civil society, other sectors-eg Use media
- Take WHO to take a leadership
- Explore whether an NGO in Cambodia would like to like to take up an exercise similar to the African monitoring shown in the countdown.

China

- Continue to talk to minister of finance to get financial support
- Government needs to support areas which are yet to reach MDG

Indonesia

Strong commitment from Government

Priority is poor people

Bring together stake holders

Need technical assistance from International governments

N.Korea

- Government is working for MNCH
- Attaching importance for training staff
- Review the coverage interventions with their partners
- _we need help for supply of medicines and tackling malnutrition

Lao PDR

- Situational analysis of MDGs 4&5 and will change the policies accordingly
- Strict M&E with review meetings
- Coordinate all of the stake holders and external partners to work better

Philippines

- Formula One –to be implemented to all provinces.
